Let us pray for continued good weather and health!

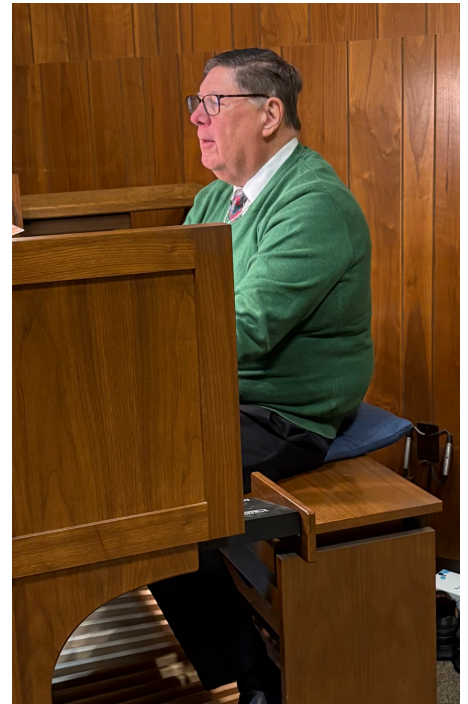
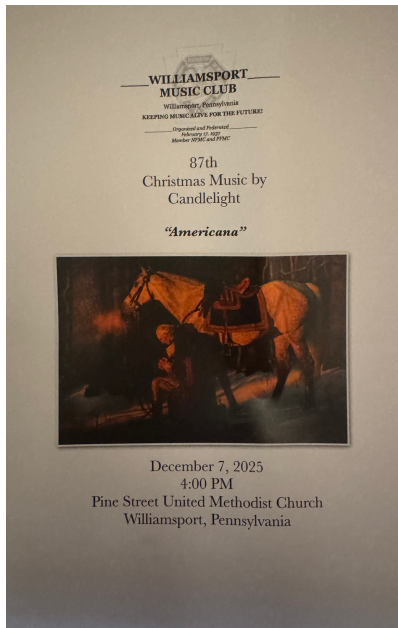

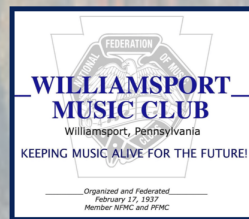
